WHEREAS; there is an ongoing need to recognize and support the important contributions of Service Support Staffs to the citizens of the State of Wisconsin;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim September 2014, as
