*W*HEREAS, direct support professionals must build close and trusted relationships with the individuals they help to support; and

*W*HEREAS, direct support professionals help those with disabilities remain connected to their families and fully integrated in their communities; and

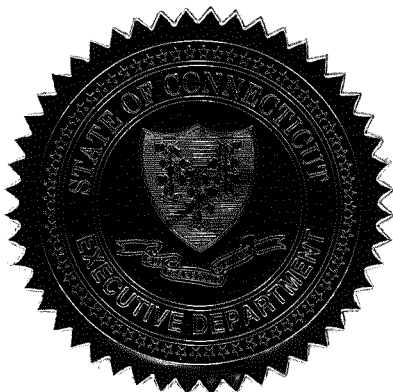
*W*HEREAS, direct support professionals provide critical assistance to individuals in home and community based settings so they are able to live meaningful and productive lives; and
